Port Notice

This Port Notice applies within the limits of the Port of Brisbane and its strategic port land and with respect to the port facilities owned or controlled by the Port of Brisbane Corporation (“the Port Area”).

Failure to comply with this notice is an offence: Max Penalty – 100 Penalty Units

Over Side Maintenance

Allowable Ship Maintenance While at Berths and in Brisbane Port Limits:

Painting Over Side

- No Chipping/Scraping/Sanding on vessel hull or over side fittings may occur where any residues may fall into the river. On the wharf side, drop sheets may be used to catch residues and these must be disposed of amongst ships garbage.
- A fresh water wash down may be undertaken before painting.
- Painting on either side of the ship may take place as long as paint cans are secured such that they are unable to fall or spill into the river/bay. They may be placed in a basket and hung separate from the stage/chair. In all cases no paint residue may enter the waterways. Over side spray painting is not permitted. On berths not controlled by the Port of Brisbane Corporation permission should also be sought from the owner of the wharf.

Over Side Ship Maintenance

- No over side maintenance may occur without the written permission of the Port Of Brisbane Corporation and in strict accordance with any conditions attached to such permission. As a general requirement no residues are allowed to enter the river or bay.
- If any underwater cutting or welding is necessary then all residues must be retrieved on board. Work must only proceed upon receipt of a “Permission to Undertake Over Side Work” which will be forwarded to the shipping company or its agent. (Refer to the Port Procedures Manual – Section 12, Appendix 27).

Port of Brisbane Corporation and Queensland Transport (Duty Harbour Master) are to be advised 48 hours before arrival of ship at Pilot boarding ground.
